JACK RANKIN

- Jack was elected to represent Central Windsor on the Royal Borough in 2015 and was appointed to the Cabinet the following year. He is the Cabinet Member for Economic Development, Property, Communications and Deputy Finance. He is also Chairman of the Windsor Town Forum and is the Royal Borough representative on the Thames Valley Berkshire Local Enterprise Partnership.
- Jack has worked for Centrica since 2014, where he currently works in Mergers and Acquisitions.
- He graduated from the University of Warwick with a Masters in Mathematics and Physics in 2014, during which time he was the Chairman of the University of Warwick Conservative Association. He met Sarah, his wife, during his time at university.
- In 2017 he stood for Parliament against the Angela Rayner MP in Ashton-Under-Lyne, increasing the Conservative vote share in the constituency by the largest margin since 1950.
